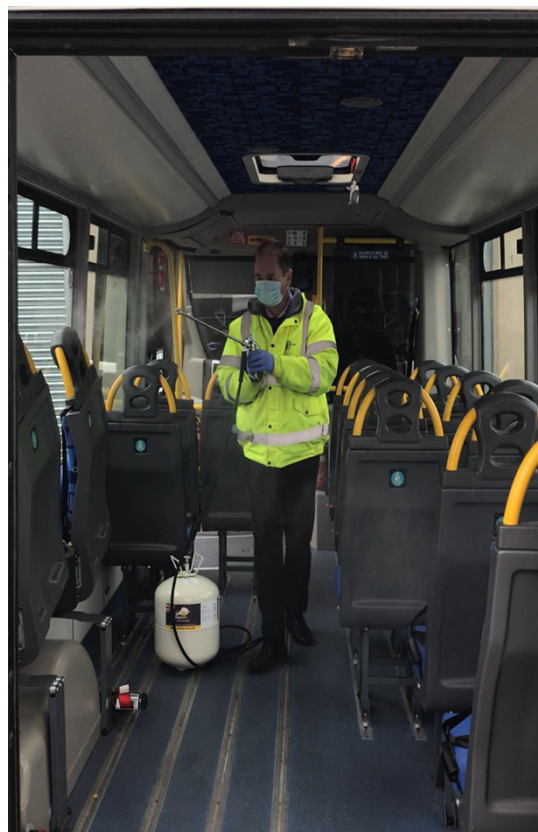


At Rotherham Community Transport the Safety of our drivers and staff has always been our primary concern. We have put in place additional safety measures during the outbreak and are closely following Government and Public Health England guidelines and recommendations. All our vehicles are regularly sanitised, staff are issued with personal protective equipment including hand sanitiser, wipes, disposable gloves and face masks.

From the 1st of July RCT will be commencing a limited Dial-A-Ride Service, Monday to Friday between 09:00 till 17:00, to enable people to undertake essential journeys. We will be limiting the number of passengers travelling on each journey to allow adequate social distancing and after each journey all points of contact, hand rails, seatbelts etc are disinfected with antibacterial wipes and sprays.

As another safety precaution we will also not be accepting cash on our vehicles instead we will be operating a prepayment record for passengers to use, this will work by passengers activating their personal prepayment record with a card payment over the telephone or by sending us a cheque before they travel, for further information or to set up a prepayment record call our booking centre on 01709 517100. Our Booking Centre will continue to operate limited opening hours of Monday to Friday 09:30 - 13:30 until further notice.

We will be constantly monitoring future Government advice/guidelines and will review our services and the way we work to keep everyone safe.
